The Board's President, Dr. Gerber, determined this meeting was properly noticed with the Secretary of State's office and a sufficient number of Board members were in attendance to constitute a quorum. The quorum was determined by the presence of Dr. Gerber, Dr. Veltri (via video conference), Dr. Black, Dr. Bogers, Dr. Kaczkowski, Mrs. Shea, Dr. Smith, and Mrs. Stevens. Therefore, the meeting of the West Virginia Board of Dentistry was called to order.

The first order of business was the meeting notice to the Secretary of State which was distributed for information purposes only.

At this time the President announced the need for an Executive Session to consider matters under provisions contained in Chapter 6, Article 9A, Section 4, not limited to, but primarily for those

contained in Subsections (4) and (6). Specifically to give law exams and interview the applicants in the morning and review complaints and investigations thereafter. Upon motion by Mrs. Beverly L. Stevens, and properly seconded by Dr. John E. Bogers, and unanimously passed, the Board went into executive session for the reasons stated. Thereafter, the Board came back into a general session upon motion by Mrs. MaryBeth Shea, and properly seconded by Dr. Stan W. Kaczkowski, and unanimously passing.

The next order of business was the consideration of recommendations by the complaint committee concerning Case Nos. 2019-DB-0008D and 2019-DB-0019D. The complaint committee recommended the cases be combined under Case No. 2019-DB-0019D and recommended the summary suspension of Dr. John E. Brock, the dentist in this matter. Upon motion by Dr. John E. Bogers, and properly seconded by Mrs. Beverly L. Stevens, and unanimously passed, the Board approved the committee recommendations. The license of Dr. Brock will be summarily suspended upon finalization of a Board Order.

The next order of business was the consideration of recommendations by the complaint committee concerning Case No. 2019-DB-0005D. The complaint committee recommended thirty day letters requesting a response concerning the allegations in this case be sent to the appropriate licensees. Upon motion by Dr. Byron H. Black, and properly seconded by Dr. Charles L. Smith, and unanimously passed, the Board approved the committee recommendation.

The next order of business was application number 2018-51, Dr. Courtney E. Lough, for a license to practice dentistry. Having completed requirements requested by the Board, Dr. Charles L. Smith made a motion to grant the license to Dr. Lough. Mrs. Beverly L. Stevens seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

The next order of business was application number 2019-07, Dr. Ghaddy Alsaty, for a resident permit. Mrs. Beverly L. Stevens made a motion the resident permit be issued, Dr. Stan W. Kaczkowski seconded the motion, the motion for resident permit failed unanimously. The resident permit will be denied.

The next order of business was application number 2019-08, Dr. Mohamad Sarraj, for a resident permit. Dr. Byron H. Black made a motion the resident permit be issued, Dr. Stan W. Kaczkowski seconded the motion, the motion for resident permit failed unanimously. The resident permit will be denied.

At this time the meeting was adjourned upon motion of Mrs. MaryBeth Shea, properly seconded by Dr. Stan W. Kaczkowski, and unanimously passing.
